SCHEV PERFORMANCE STATISTICS

For each Virginia location, and for the most recent academic year, the total number of students who were enrolled as well as the total number and percentage of students who were enrolled in each program offered; 148 students enrolled in 2023. 100% were enrolled in the Cosmetology program.

For each Virginia location, the total number of students who completed or graduated from the school as of the end of the last academic year and the total number and percentage of students who completed or graduated from each program offered by the school as of the end of the last academic year; and 99 students graduated in 2023, at a graduation rate of 65.13%. Of the 99 eligible graduates, 50 reported employment in their field of study within 6 months of graduation and 21 reported employment within 1 year of graduation.

The percentage of students receiving federal financial aid (if applicable) and the average student indebtedness at graduation is:

- 83.11% of students who started school between 1/1/2023-12/31/2023 received federal financial aid. The average student indebtedness at graduation for students who completed the program between 1/1/2023-12/31/2023 is \$9,146.36.
